



FLOOD PREPAREDNESS

Winter is here and multiple rainy days are forecasted for the last two weeks of this month. Take steps now to protect your farm and equipment from potential flooding impacts.

EMERGENCY MAP

MOVE EQUIPMENT

Move to higher ground away from flood prone or inundation prone areas.



MOVE PESTICIDES AND OTHER CHEMICALS TO A SAFE AREA

It is imperative that you secure above-ground storage tanks and consider storing pesticides away from flood-prone areas to avoid contamination.

Other chemicals such as fuels or fertilizers should also be secured and stored in safe locations.

When storing pesticides and other chemicals, it is important to continue to follow all regulatory labeling and storing requirements. For example, pesticides must be stored in a locked enclosure and storage areas must be posted with the following:

- DANGER
- POISON STORAGE AREA
- ALL UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS KEEP OUT
- KEEP DOOR LOCKED WHEN NOT IN USE
