Resolution Adding the Monterey Bay
National Marine Sanctuary to the Big Sur
Multi-Agency Advisory Council

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors established the Big Sur Multi-Agency Advisory Council by Resolution No. 86-443 on July 8, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Council has functioned well to facilitate communication and coordination among the governmental agencies with jurisdiction in the Big Sur Area and the Big Sur residents, property owners, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 1994, the Board of Supervisors amended Resolution No. 86-443 to include the 27th District State Assembly Member, and in March, 1997 amended the resolution to include the 15th District State Senate Member, and the Council has benefited from these additions; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on April 7, 2000, the Big Sur Multi-Agency Advisory Council voted unanimously to recommend to the Board of Supervisors the addition of the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, hereby amends its Resolution No. 86-443 by amending "Section 2, Membership" to add the name, "Director of the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary".
