B. AMR Nurse Navigation	B. (Mike Esslinger) Introduction of AMR Nurse Navigation team making the presentation. Nurse Navigation gives another option to the dispatcher in addition to a standard EMS response. Uses an algorithm to find the right for the patient clinical services, at the right time, and right resources. Will be phased in process. Anticipated to affect 3-7% of total EMS call volume initially. After full adoption, looking at a 7-13% of EMS call volume. At maturity, 10-15% of EMS call volume is likely to be referred. Infrastructure includes established protocols, 24/7 Nurse Navigation Centers, and supporting technology. So far, AMR Nurse Navigation has had 250,000 encounters without a negative outcome. Currently 2 centers running with 75 nurse navigators. Program has received positive feedback.	B. N/A

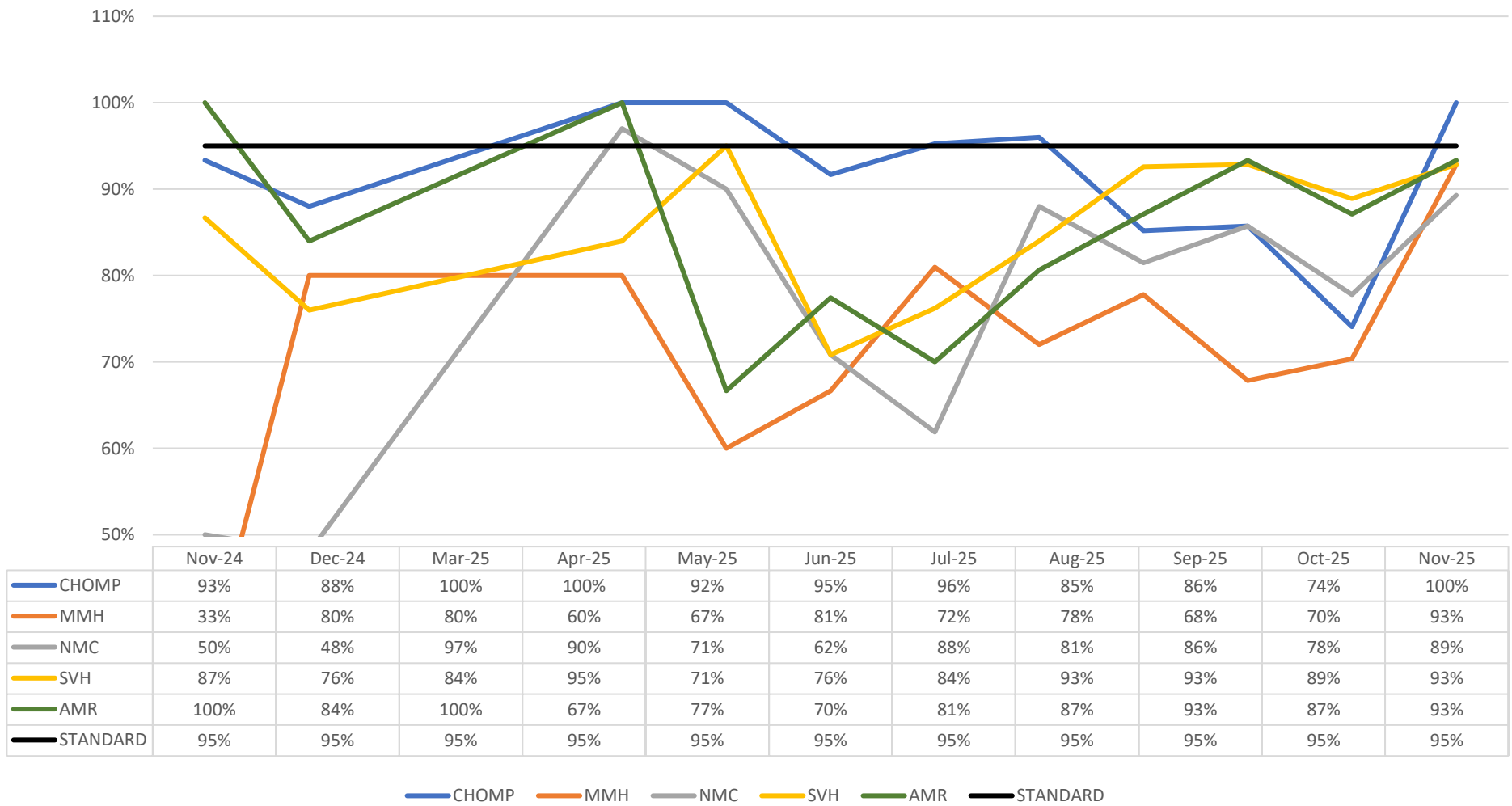

C. Seneca Center	<p>AMR putting together 5 workgroups to address questions of stakeholder groups. There is no cost to the patient. GMR will pay for the Uber ride. There is no charge to the patient for Nurse Navigation. Working to build a resource directory to have as many options for patients as possible.</p> <p>C. (Jenna Fordis) Seneca is a Pediatric Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) to support young people and their families. Patients can stay up to 23 hours and 59 minutes. Unless the patient is to be admitted as an in-patient, the patient is to go back into the community by 24 hours. Patients won't be kicked out. Facility is unlocked and can take up to 4 youth at a time. Must be medically stable. Referral priorities are from Mobile Crisis Teams, County Behavioral Health, and ED. Service for patients age 6 to 17 in mental health crisis and reside in the County of Monterey. It is a multi-disciplinary team with clinicians, RNs, telepsychiatrists, and youth stabilization specialist. Has 24/7 bilingual capacity. Serve insured and uninsured. Need to be voluntary at this time. The assessment process was described. Current options for care are discharge home for community care or inpatient psychiatric facility if unable to keep themselves safe. The referral process was described for intake and output.</p>	C. 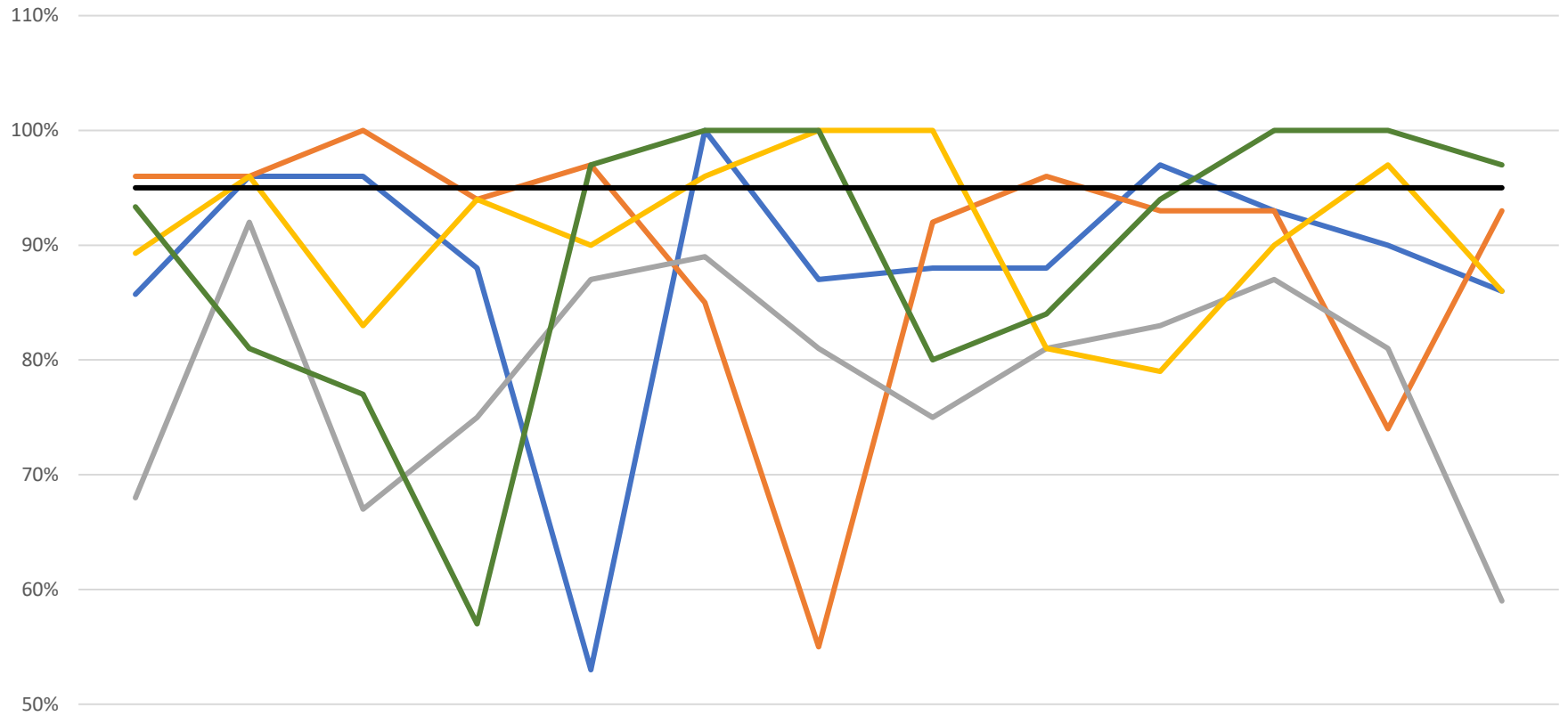
