



Young Supervisors Program Application

Program Description:

The Young Supervisors Program is a four-week long program which is open to high school and college students that reside or attend schools in Monterey County. This program was originally founded in 2011 and was previously known as the Young Assemblymembers Program. It was created in order to provide the young people of Salinas and the surrounding areas with an opportunity to develop skills in leadership, team building, problem solving and further comprehend the importance of both civic participation and higher education.



The Program:

Participants go on an initial two-day leadership development training to sharpen and learn leadership skills. At the end of the four weeks the participants will be able to effectively communicate with others, have a background in community service and organization, while illustrating an understanding of the legislative process and the workings of a County Supervisor. The participants will be able to refer to their time with the program and use that as work and volunteer experience. Furthermore, the Young Supervisors Program aims to spark an interest in the young adults to become civically engaged and take part in the democratic process.

The Young Supervisors Program is free of charge and will be held at the Monterey County Government Building, located at 168 W. Alisal St. Second Floor, Salinas CA, 93901.

Strategy and Implementation:

The Young Supervisors Program is a 4-week long summer program that will begin on July 1 and will end on July 23 and will cover the following topics.

- Leadership workshops
- Environmental Research and Coastal Protection
- Observation of Supervisors Board Meeting, Guest Speakers, and Community Tours
- Monterey Bay Whale Watching Tour and History Walk
- Graduation Ceremony and Mock Hearing

Applications for the program are due on June 20

Javier Gomez and Jasmine Mejia Cortez, Young Supervisors Program Directors, will oversee the daily operations and activities.

What do you receive for participating?

Participants will receive a certificate of recognition and letter of recommendation for the student's month-long commitment and completion of the program. Students can also use Supervisor Alejo for a job or scholarship reference and can list participation in the program on their resume.
